Report from the Editors of *Antichthon*

During 2006 the Editors completed a revised Volume 38 (2004), the original of which had to be withdrawn because of technical faults. Volume 39 (2005) was completed and dispatched in the middle of the year. Volume 40 (2006), the first *Antichthon* special issue (“Catullus in Contemporary Perspective”), with Marguerite Johnson and Terry Ryan as Guest Editors, was completed and dispatched at the end of the year. This means that *Antichthon* is now up to date.

One major reason for this surge of productivity was the fact that Bruce Marshall took up the challenge of preparing the papers for each volume and negotiating with the printer at Macquarie University. The Editors wish to recognize Bruce’s extraordinary efficiency and his keen eye, and to thank him warmly for his readiness to invest so much of his time in the Society’s journal.
