



The *ASCS* New Zealand Student Essay Competition in Honour of John Barsby

This competition is open to any undergraduate student enrolled in a Classics paper at the 100, 200 and 300 level at any tertiary institution in New Zealand during 2010, whose essay, written as part of his or her paper's internal assessment, achieved an excellent result.

The winning entrant will receive a prize valued at NZD\$200.00 and may have the opportunity to be published in an up-coming volume of the Classics journal *Scholia*. The second place entry will be acknowledged with an award valued at NZD\$75.00.

Essays should be typed and include a cover sheet giving the title of the essay, the entrant's university affiliation and their personal contact details. The entrant's name must not appear on any pages of the essay itself. The essay should not exceed 3000 words (including notes and bibliography).
